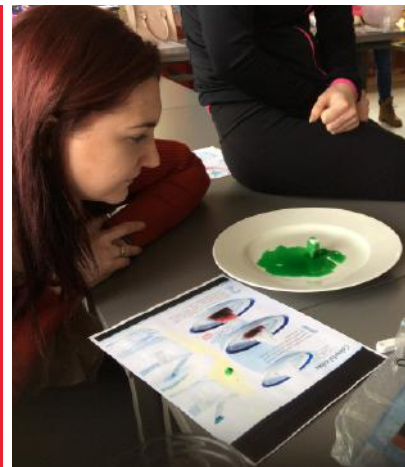


READING OF THE PROCLAMATION
